Approximate Schedule for this week: (I've made some adjustments to math. Rather than do the ch. 11 review this week I am going to do the chapter 11 math test with the students like I would normally do the chapter review. This is due to time constraints that I didn't anticipate when I made the original calendar.)

Monday - Math 11.9 Religion, and Read Aloud

Here is what is going on this week!

Math: This week we are wrapping up chapter 11 on area and perimeter and taking our chapter 11 test together on Zoom as a class. This is different than what is in the plans, however, some adjustments needed to be made due to time constraints.

Religion: In Chapter 17 this week the students will learn about the parts of the Mass and how we are sent forth from Mass to serve God and other people. Students will complete the chapter 17 activity sheet and also the open-book test this week.

Directions:

Students will recreate a favorite scene from LHOP. Some ideas are a mobile, book cube, poster or diorama and if you can think of another way to recreate a favorite scene go for it! I'll be interested to see all of your creations! Make sure your recreated scene is labeled. A detailed paragraph should accompany your scene summarizing what is happening in it. Summaries will be read at our Zoom Meeting but not turned in. Use creativity and have fun! **These are due no later than Friday, June 5th.**

Writing: Quarantine Journal:

This is a great time to keep a daily journal so that you have it to remember this strange time of staying home, no hair cuts, masks, remote learning and your feelings about what is going on and how it has impacted you and your family.
